We are on a mission to champion continuous growth, to provide every student with opportunities, resources and practical knowledge to determine their own future. Our story has only just begun.





Application Process & Review Criteria

Application Process

Stage 1: Application Submission (14th July - 15th August, 2025)

- Prospective students complete and submit the application form on our website through HubSpot .
- Applications open on the 14th of July and close on the 15th of August 2025.

Stage 2: Application Review and Selection Process

- There are up to 50 spaces on the programme for students to grow and learn. Spaces are allocated on a first come first served basis.
- Applications are reviewed against a review framework, and top scoring candidates will be selected.

Stage 3: Verification and Parental Consent

- All students must have parental consent to take part in the programme.
- A consent form will be emailed directly to your parent/guardian for them to complete by 14th of August 2025
- Please note: Submitting your application alone is not enough your parent/guardian must complete the consent form before the application deadline for you to be considered. Unfortunately, if this isn't done in time, you won't be eligible for selection.

1. What specific topics or themes are covered in the EmpowerED workshops?

The EmpowerED workshops cover a wide range of topics related to personal and professional development, including but not limited to communication skills, emotional intelligence, goal setting, resilience, career exploration, and industry insights.

2. What age group of students does the EmpowerED Programme target?

The EmpowerED Programme targets teenagers aged 16-18 who are seeking to enhance their life skills, leadership qualities, and career prospects.

3. What is the duration of the EmpowerED Programme?

The EmpowerED Programme spans two days, with each day dedicated to specific themes and activities. Day One focuses on Law careers, while Day Two focuses on tech careers.

4. Are there any prerequisites for participating in the EmpowerED Programme?

No specific prerequisites are required to participate in the EmpowerED Programme. However, prospective participants are encouraged to have a genuine interest in personal and professional development.

5. How are participants selected for the EmpowerED Programme?

Participants are selected based on the completion and submission of the application form. The selection process prioritises early applicants due to the limited number of spaces available. Students who identify as coming from typically underrepresented groups (such as free school meals, female or non-binary, BAME, hotspot areas etc.) are prioritised.

6. Is there a fee associated with participating in the EmpowerED Programme?

No, the EmpowerED Programme is offered free of charge to selected participants. However, participants are responsible for their own transportation to and from the programme venues.

7. Can participants choose which workshops or sessions to attend during the EmpowerED Programme?

Yes! Those for Law insight day will attend Day 1 at White and case; while those for Tech insight day will attend Day 2 at IBM
